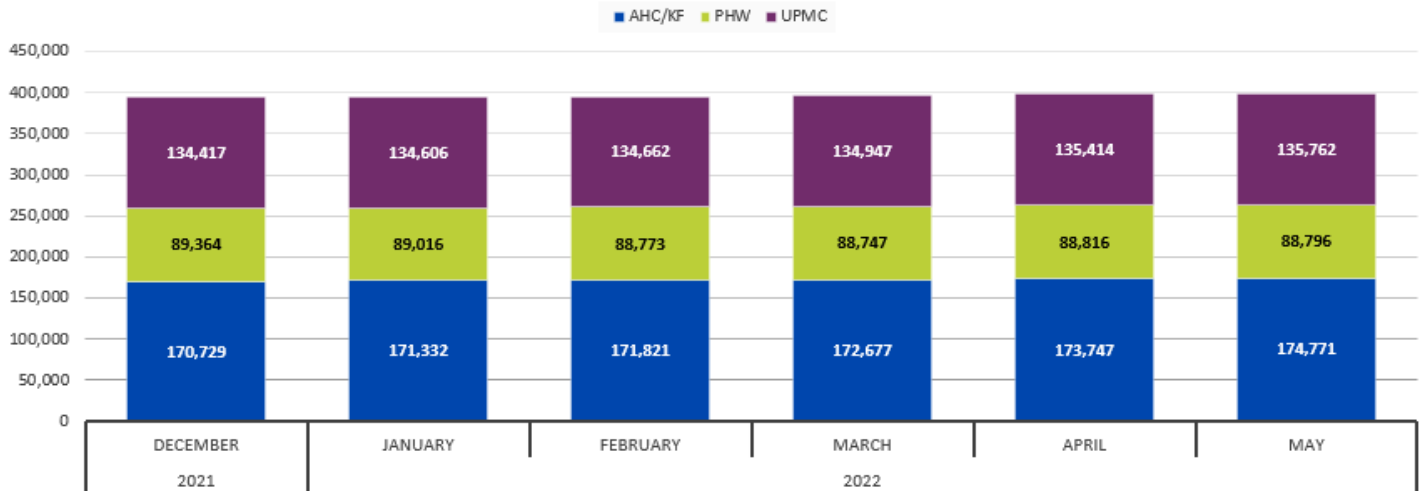

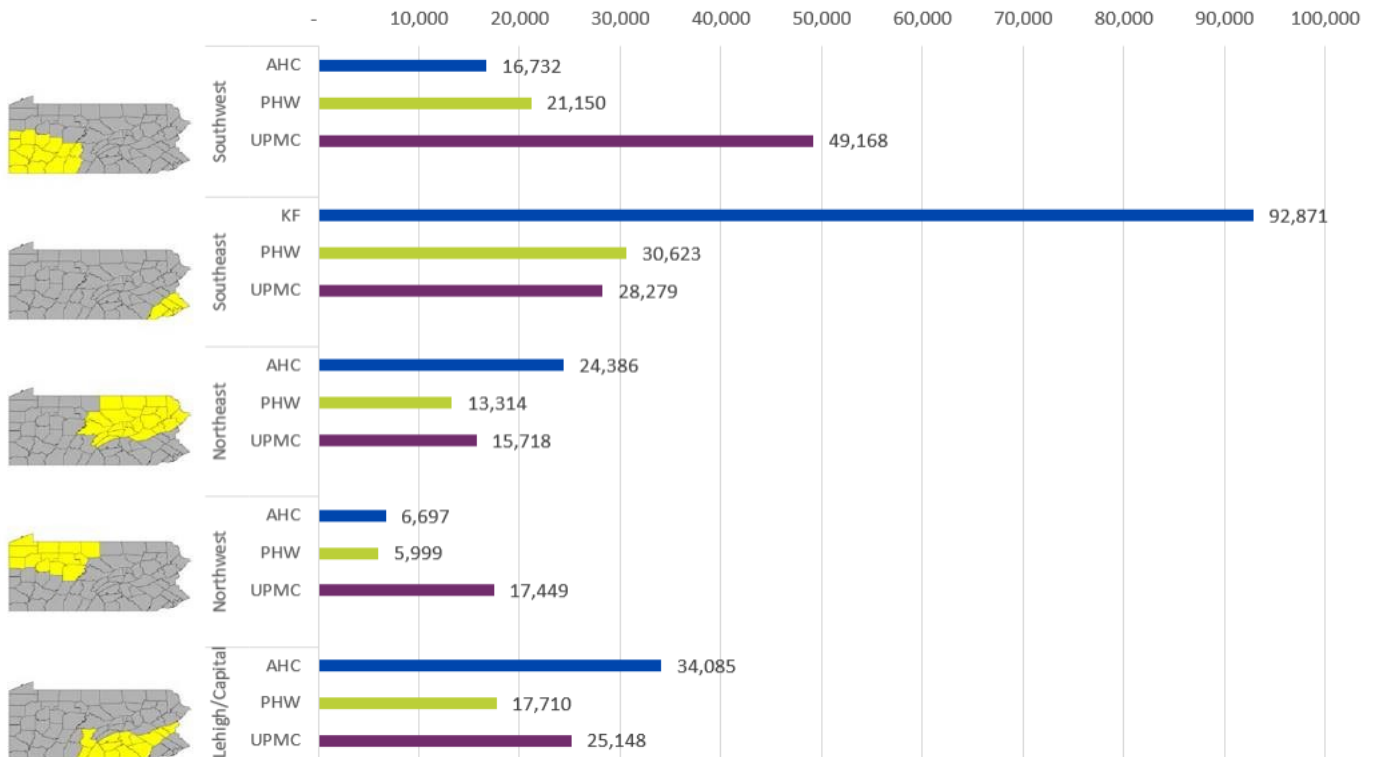
CHC Statewide Enrollments Trends by MCO

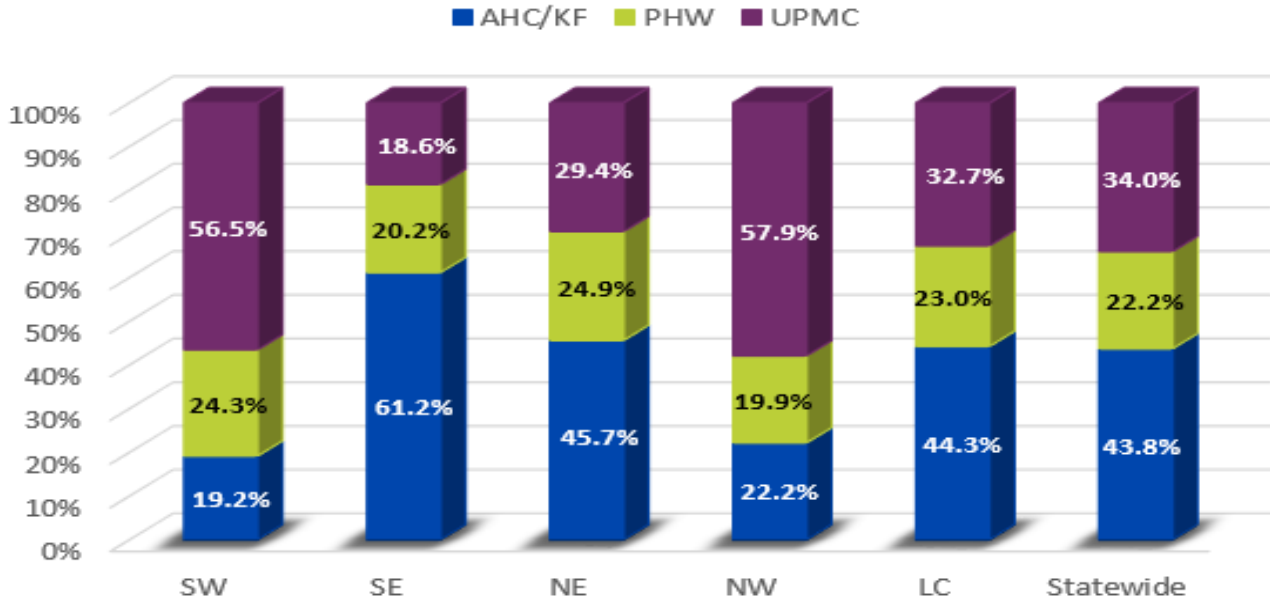
CHC Monthly Enrollment by Zone and MCO

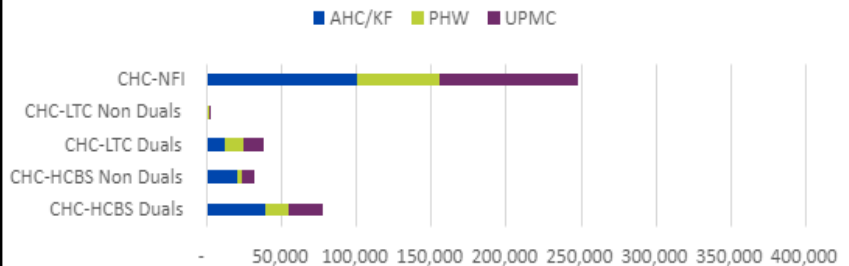

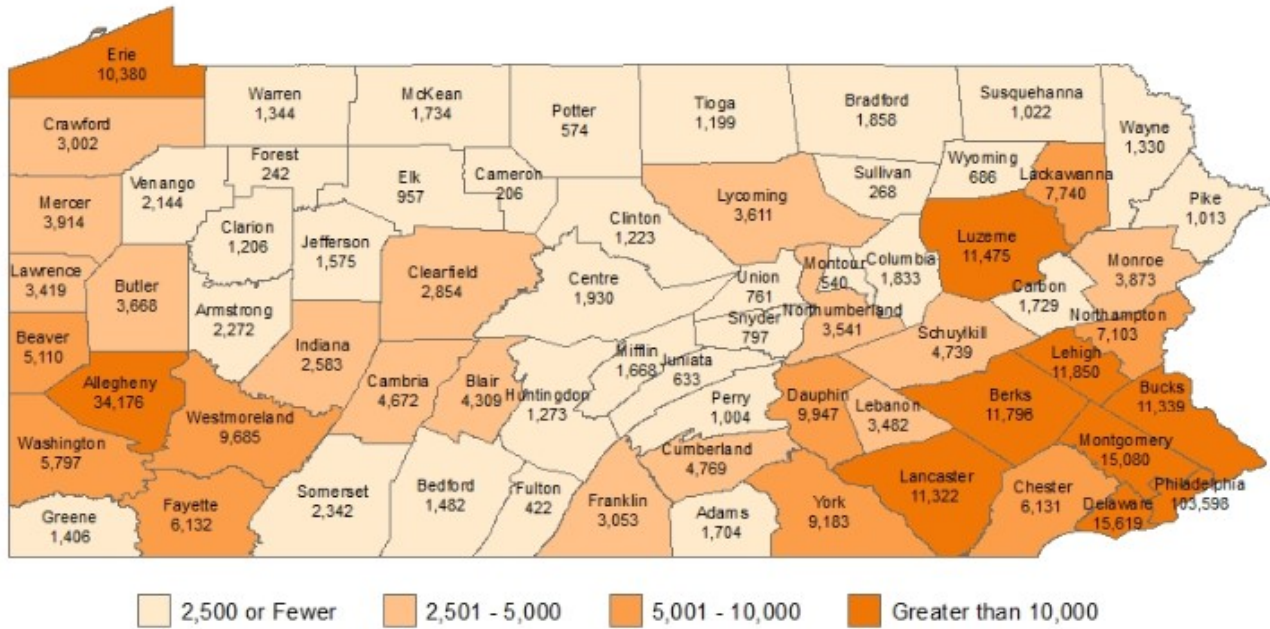

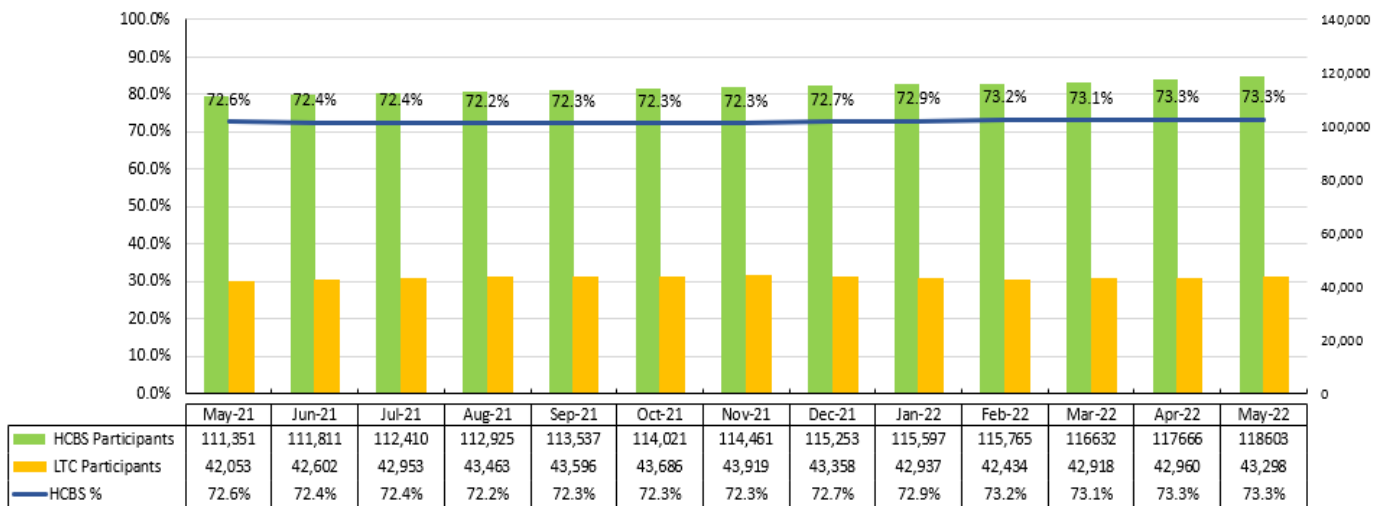
### CHC Enrollments by County\*

### Statewide LTSS Population and HCBS Percentage

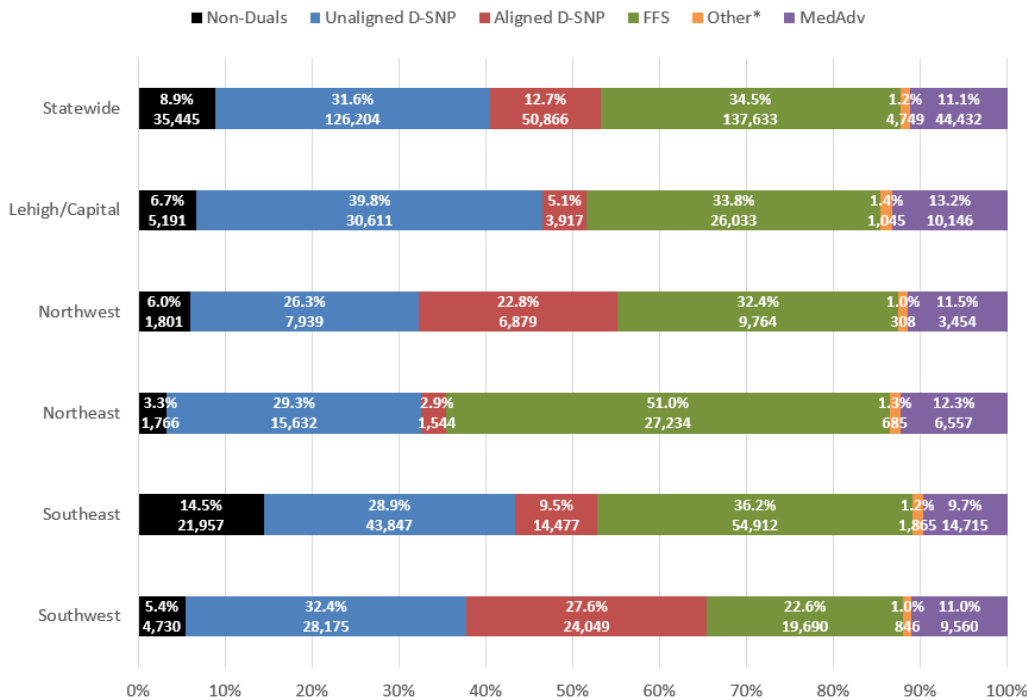

### Medicare Type for All CHC Participants by Region\*\*

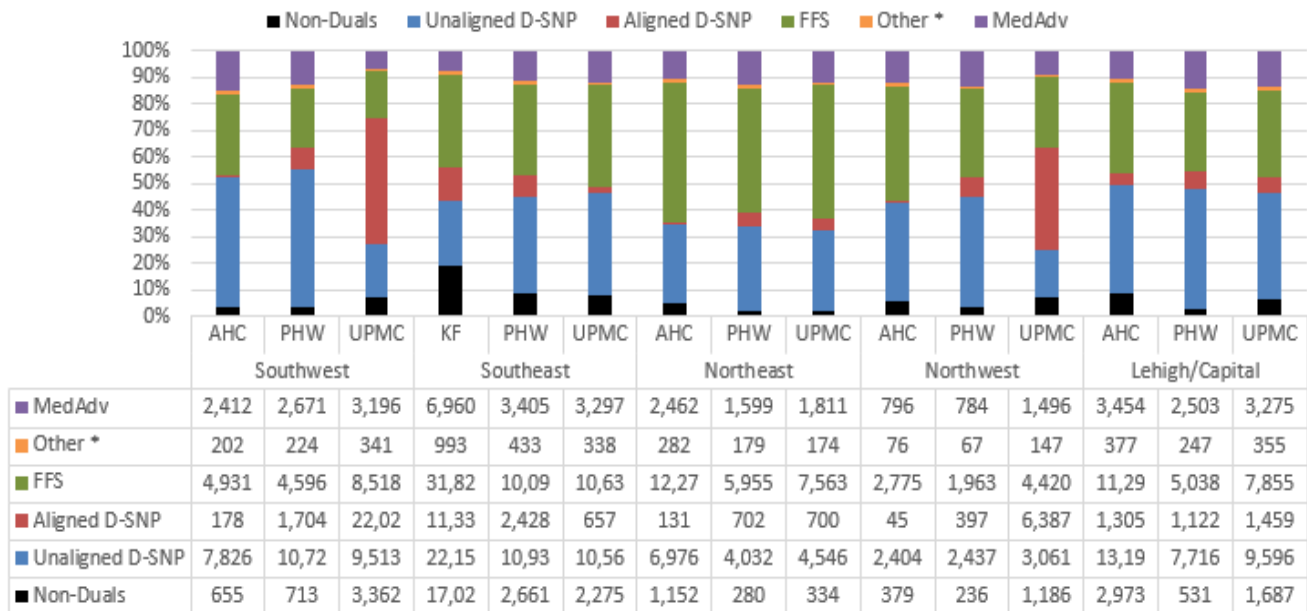


In May, the statewide percentage of non-duals increase from 8.8% to 8.9%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs increased from 12.5% to 12.7%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs increased from 30.7% to 31.6%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare decreased by 0.2% to 34.5%. Other Medicare Advantage decrease from 12.1% to 11.1% .

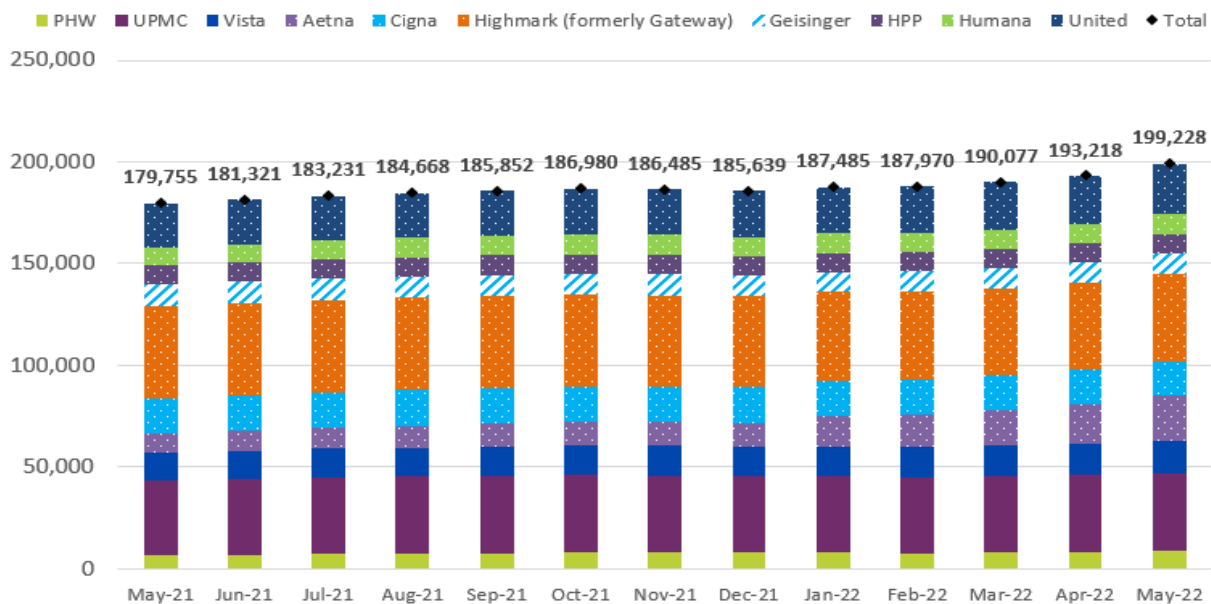

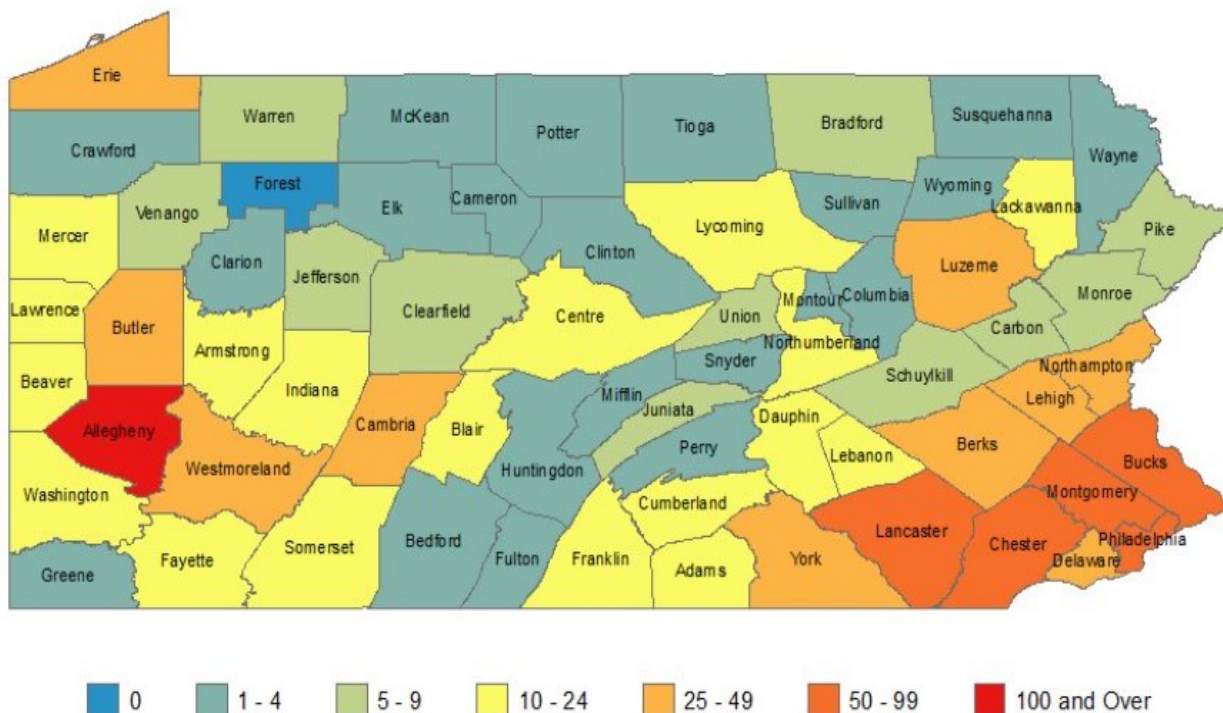
### D-SNP Enrollments by Plan

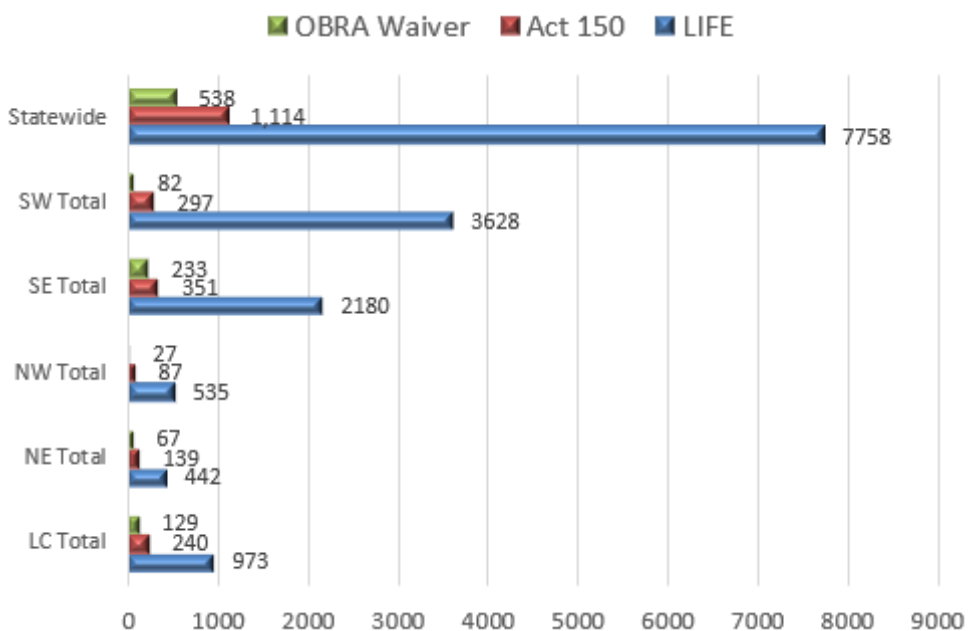

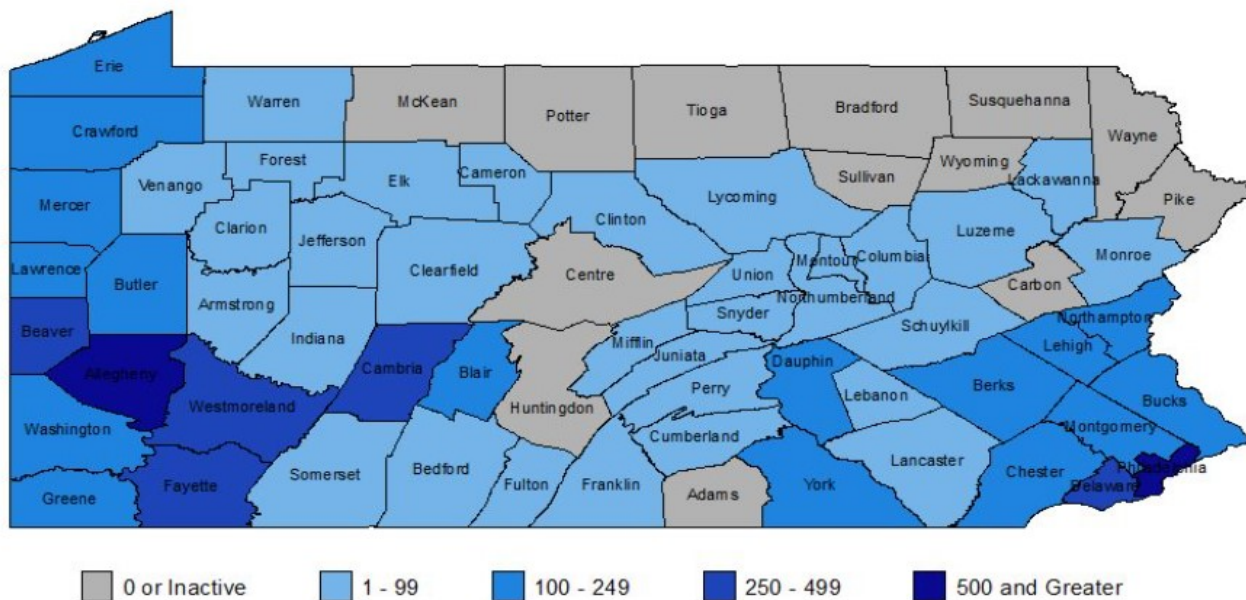
